Thank you to the 78 women who joined us to be among the first to experience Clifton Cultural Arts Center's new permanent home!

Executive Director Leslie Mooney and her team welcomed Roundtable members to their incredible new space. Together, we viewed the inaugural exhibition, "HAIRitage," by Erin Smith Glenn, winner of the inaugural New Woman juried exhibition and accompanying residency at CCAC. We sampled tai chi in one of the new studios and created a project in the CCAC maker space. Lisa Sauer, ArtsWave 2024 Campaign Co-Chair, joined Roundtable Steering Committee Chair Rosemary Schlachter to share that this year's Campaign has already raised **\$6.6 million** for the region's arts.

New and current members were among those in attendance, and we even heard from Roundtable founder Melanie Healey, who shared her motivations for establishing the

group, now celebrating its 10th anniversary, when she chaired the community-wide Campaign for ArtsWave.

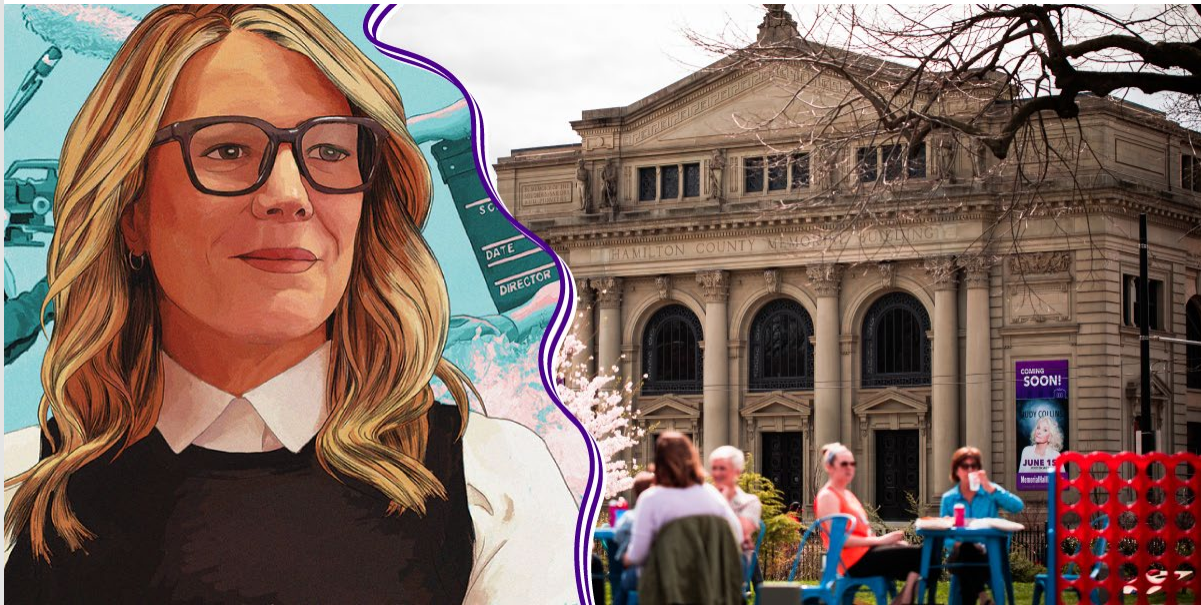

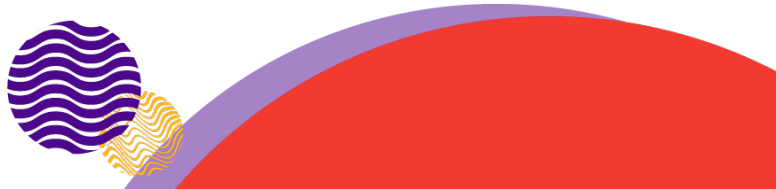
