


TRANSFORMING THE ARTS!





In a word ladder, you start out with a word, and then get the answer to each succeeding clue by either **adding**, **subtracting or changing only one letter** to make a different word. For example:

Garfield was one: CAT

Ford or Lincoln: CAR (change T to R)

Memento from a surgery: SCAR (add an S)

We'll spot you the first answer in the ladder. Once you've filled in the rest, you will notice that some of the slots have numbers. Find the letter in the word in that slot that corresponds to that number (so if the word was SCAR and the number was 3, you'd take the letter A). All of those letters in order from top to bottom spell a word: a bad thing for artists to do. Enter that word in to complete the puzzle!
