Last month, we celebrated Galentine's Day at the Kroger headquarters, finding inspiration in special guests from BLINK®. BLINK's executive director, Justin Brookhart, kicked things off by introducing two women who participated as artists at the iconic event.

Alicia Blum of [Kemper Sauce Studios](#) spoke on her work with the creative team behind several BLINK projects, including "[Serenade of Light](#)," the interactive installation in Washington Park that was inspired by wind chimes. Alicia and her team installed one of the interactive chimes at Kroger so that everyone present could experience it for themselves.



Kemper Sauce Studios is a Cincinnati based engineering and arts collective with an inventive spirit. Alicia Blum is an Electrical Engineer who designs lighting and power systems for sites and buildings. Her framework expands into project coordination and construction management, and collaborating on large scale projects fuels her passion for impactful design.



[**Asha Ama Bias-Daniels**](#), the creative mind behind "[**Who Do You Say That I Am,**](#)" shared how she developed BLINK's first ever runway show. The veteran fashion designer and artist has created pieces for influential figures, including Zendaya and Little Big Town, and has appeared on "Project Runway."
