ArtsWave's Boardway Bound is an acclaimed board leadership program for area professionals who are passionate about making a difference. Boardway Bound is the only leadership program developed and facilitated by arts professionals preparing and matching participants for arts board service.

Since 2004, ArtsWave has trained and placed over 500 individuals on arts boards, ushering a new generation of leadership, adding capacity to our institutions and **creating boards that represent the diverse communities each organization serves**.

Unique to **Boardway Bound!**

Program and content



Boardway Bound provides interactive content and conversations with leaders from the Cincinnati region's arts community. Each session explores real-life issues confronting arts boards and provides time for networking with fellow participants and the local arts community, sponsored by Thomson Hine LLP.

Boardway Bound includes seven in-person sessions at ArtsWave, culminating in our signature "Speed Dating" event. Participatory sessions will be facilitated by arts professionals and experienced board members, supplemented by relevant articles, videos and sample board materials. The final gathering will be a graduation celebration to celebrate our new board leaders.

A defining feature of Boardway Bound is our "Speed Dating" interview process. In the final session, candidates come face-to-face with arts clients for mutual interviews. ArtsWave then matches the top choices of participants with the top choices of arts clients to begin a relationship that they define together.

Whether participants want to learn more about nonprofit governance and the Cincinnati Arts Sector or just make new connections, Boardway Bound is a great way to get started. The program is practically designed to culminate in our speed dating session, introducing participants to arts and cultural organizations recruiting new board members. Although all expertise is welcome, there has been particular interest for strength in finance, human resources and the law.

ArtsWave encourages candidates from all backgrounds to apply. Together, we can ensure that the programs and practices of the region's arts and cultural organizations are reflective of our entire community.
